## LOCATION

Ottawa ([www.ottawa.ca](http://www.ottawa.ca)) is located in the Ottawa Valley in eastern Ontario. It lies on the banks of the Ottawa River, which divides the provinces of Ontario and Quebec in the area. The mouths of the Rideau River and the Rideau Canal are both located here and have played a major part in the history of Ottawa.

Ottawa's natural environment is a very large part of its identity. The Rideau Canal is the world's largest skating rink and is used by Ottawa residents and visitors alike. The city has 850 parks that contribute to Ottawa's green character.

Ottawa honours a long tradition of Canadian culture and history in the many world-class institutions in the city: the National Arts Centre, the Canadian Museum of Civilization, and the National Gallery of Canada, to name just a few. Ottawa is well known as a festival city, boasting over 45 major festivals taking place each year.

The tournament games will be played at Heritage Park, which is located on Orleans Boulevard in Orleans. A practice diamond, Trillium Park, is located at 2030 Ogilvie Road. The concession at Heritage Park will be selling the usual fast-food tournament fare plus a range of health conscious foods.

## EVENTS SCHEDULE

**Pre-tournament Managers/Coaches Meeting:** This meeting will be held on Sunday, July 11<sup>th</sup>, at 4:00 p.m., place to be determined. After the managers/coaches meeting, the Tournament Committee will host a get together (at around 5:30 p.m.) at Local Heroes Restaurant located at 1760 St. Laurent Blvd, just down the street from the Chimo hotel. Here the managers and coaches will have an opportunity to meet Tournament Committee members and other volunteers, the tournament umpires, and each other.

This is a mandatory meeting for all managers and coaches. The District Administrator and the Umpire-in-Chief will review rules and ground rules. The coin toss will be done for the round robin games.

Please bring your affidavit and one copy of the medical release form for each player with you to this meeting. The affidavit and release forms will be held by the Tournament Director for the duration of the tournament and will be returned to you at the end of the tournament before you leave.

If you are bringing pins, bring them to this meeting. We will give all pins to the players as part of the souvenir package they will receive at the team breakfast.

**Opening Ceremony:** The opening ceremony will take place at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, July 12<sup>th</sup> at Heritage Park. All teams will be present in uniform.

**Tournament Breakfast:** This will be held at 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday, July 13<sup>th</sup> at the Chimo Hotel, 1199 Joseph Cyr Street in Ottawa ([www.chimohotel.com](http://www.chimohotel.com)). Directions will be provided at the Managers meeting.

- Head **west** on **Lemieux St** 62 m
- 2.Slight **left** to stay on **Lemieux St** 47 m
- 3.Turn **left** at **St Laurent Blvd** 0.2 km
- 4.Take the **ON-417/TC Hwy** ramp 0.4 km
- 5.Merge onto **King's Hwy 417 E/TC E** 0.7 km
- 6.Continue on **Regional Rd-174 E** (signs for **Rockland/Orleans/County Rd-174**) 5.5 km
- 7.Take the **Jeanne d'Arc** exit South 1.5 km
- 8.South then East on **Jeanne d'Arc to Orleans Blvd.(4th road to right)**. 1.0 km
- 9. South (right) on **Orleans Blvd to Heritage Park** on the right. Parking lot at the ballpark. 1.0
